

8. FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 2846, MANDATORY SPAY AND NEUTER WITHIN CITY LIMITS

Attorney Simpson read by short title:

ORDINANCE NO. 2846

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, CREATING SECTION 4-78 (MANDATORY SPAY AND NEUTER) PROVIDING FOR MANDATORY SPAY AND NEUTER OF DOGS AND CATS HARBORED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR UNALTERED PERMITS; PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; AMENDING SECTION 4-52 (FEES) TO DELETE LICENSE FEES FOR DOGS AND CATS THAT ARE NOT SPAYED OR NEUTERED AND PROVIDING A FEE FOR AN UNALTERED PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
